PARKING OPTIONS

1 Muriel Henchman Park / The Spit

- *Free council managed parking
- *Included standard car space and large trailer parking areas
- *Direct access to boat ramps, Broadwater, jetty

Street parking on Muriel Henchman Drive

- *Limited (6 spaces in some sections)
- *Often free with 2 hour limits in some sections

2 Parking along Seaworld Drive

short walk (2-10mins depending on location)

- *Seaworld Drive roadside parking bays
- *Common overflow option when park fills up
- *Mix of free and time-limited spaces

3 Doug Jennings Park (The Spit)

large capacity alternative (3km | 4min drive)

- *huge overflow option (approximate 200-300 spaces)
- *free parking
- *open 24/7 (some overnight restrictions)

Important parking tips

- *Follow signage carefully – Gold Coast Council enforce parking rules with fines

Quick Recommendation

- *First try – Muriel Henchman Park car park (on site)
- *If full – Seaworld Drive street parking
- *Busy day fallback – Doug Jennings Park (large and free)

WHAT TO BRING

- 1 Paddle
- 2 Eftpos/Bank card
- 3 Personal flotation device (PFD)
- 4 Hydration Pack
- 5 Sun Hat
- 6 Sunscreen / Sunglasses
- 7 Suitable clothing and footwear
- 8 Positive attitude and team spirit!

SAFETY

- 1 Follow instructions from officials and safety boats.
- 2 Wear your PFD if required.
- 3 Look after fellow Paddlers.
- 4 First aid will be available on the safety boat. If you need assistance let your steerer know.
- 5 *Bank cards/mobile phone can be clearly labelled in a plastic bag with your name printed clearly on it and placed in a collective dry bag on the safety boat.
- 6 *Other personal belongings – car keys, change of clothes are to be left at home base in the Paddle House which will be locked until our return.

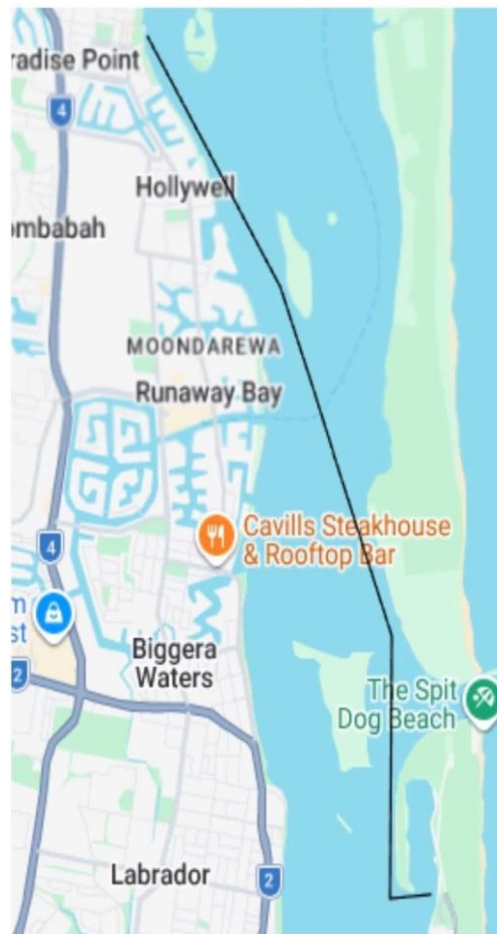
COURSE FOR LEG 1

Departing from our home site, Gold Coast Outrigger Canoe Club, we will make our way to Paradise Point.

We will have a comfort stop with a snack provided to share to keep our energy levels up.

Coffee is available to buy, so bring along your EFT card.

Toilets are available at this stop.



Leg 1 – 8.0 km

COURSE FOR LEG 2

Paradise Point to Couran Cove.

We will have snacks including biscuits, muesli bars, lollies... This will take us across the main channel where we often see marine life like dolphins, turtles... so fingers crossed.



Leg 2 – 7.8 km

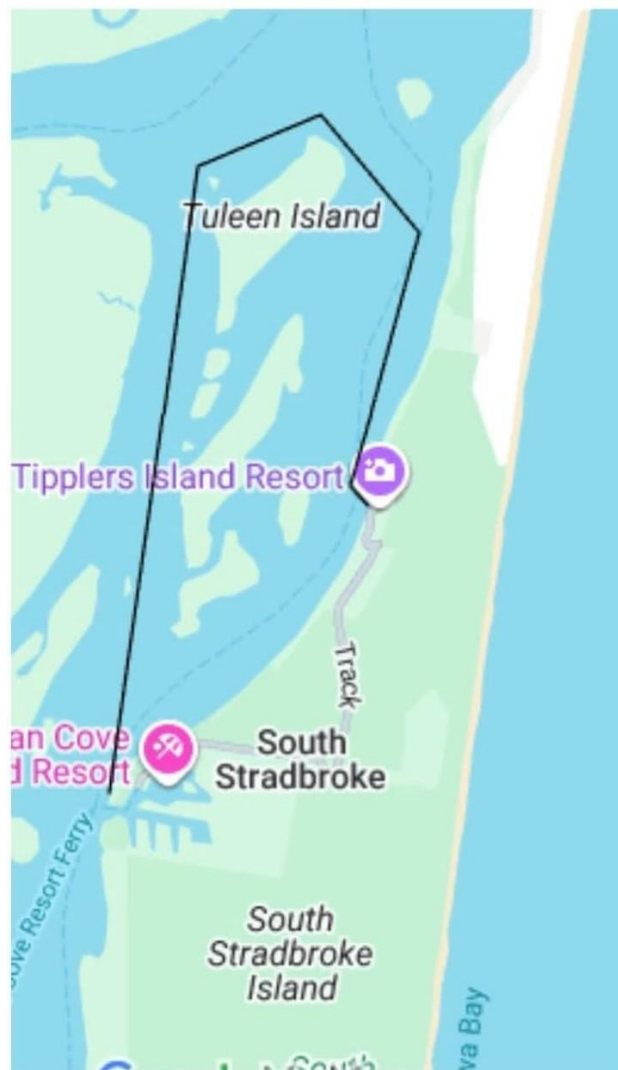
COURSE FOR LEG 3

Couran Cove to Tipplers Cafe/kiosk.

Lunch and beverages will be available to purchase so make sure to bring your bank card along. An opportunity to top up that drink bladder pack.

Toilets are available at this stop.

The paddle will take us around Tuleen and a few other little islands in the middle of the Gold Coast Broadwater.



Leg 3 – 8.3 km

COURSE LEG 4

Tipplers Cafe/Kiosk to North Currigee Campground.

A comfort stop for snacks and fruits.

If time permits we can take a quick walk to the other side of the site to enjoy the serenity of a deserted beach.



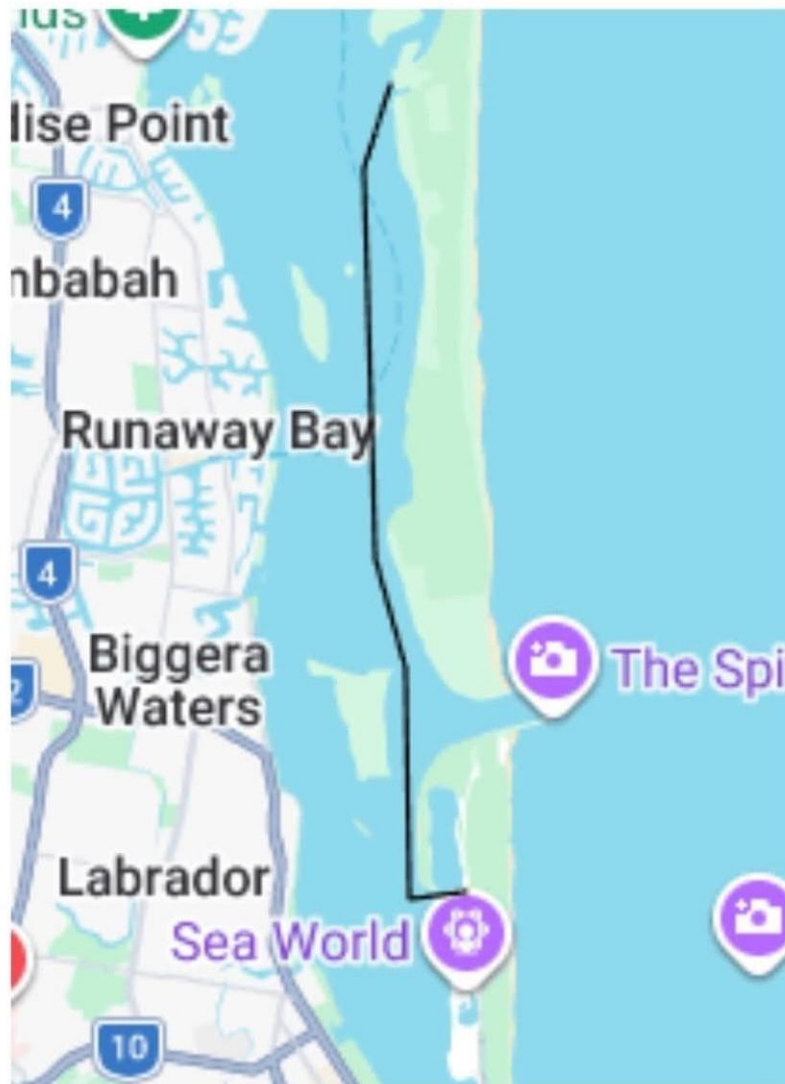
Leg 4 – 10.0 km

COURSE LEG 5

North Currigee Campground to home base GCOCC Paddle House.

Paddling in front of Wave Break Island will give us a glimpse of the ocean through the seaway.

Once back at base, can we ask that everyone helps to put the canoes and equipment away before saying goodbye.



Leg 5 – 7.8km
